Over the past 30 years the veterinary school in Grafton has been transformed. Our beautiful 580-acre site has become a full-fledged campus boasting comprehensive teaching, research, and clinical facilities. Our teaching hospitals feature leading-edge veterinary clinical services including sophisticated imaging tools such as our high-resolution MRI for small and large animal patients. We have built a pioneering Wildlife Clinic, a critical-care and specialty clinic in Walpole, Mass., and a larger ambulatory services facility in Woodstock, Conn. And this past June we opened the Agnes Varis Campus Center.

We are especially proud of what has been taking place inside the doors of our facilities, including exceptional educational experiences for veterinary professional and graduate students, interns, and residents. Thanks to a world-class faculty, the Cummings School has excelled from day one.
